



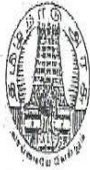

2. The Director of Medical Education has submitted the proposal along with the Inspection Report and Project Report of the Trust to the Government for considering the request made by the Santha Medical Foundation, Villupuram to grant permission to start a Post Basic B.Sc., Nursing Course at E.S. College of Nursing, Villupuram with an annual intake of 50 Students from the academic year 2009- 2010.

3. The Government have examined the case in detail in the light of the Project report, Inspection Report and the remarks of the Director of Medical Education. The Government, after careful examination, has decided to grant permission to the Trust for starting a Post Basic B.Sc., Nursing Course at E.S. College of Nursing, Villupuram with an annual intake of 50 Students from the academic year 2010-2011, subject to the following conditions:

- a) The Trust should construct its building for the proposed Post Basic B.Sc., Nursing course and Hostel before starting the course.

- b) Admission of students shall be made as per the rules fixed by the Government from time to time.
- c) Tuition fees including special fees should be collected from the students at the same rates as prescribed by the Government from time to time. The Management should also give separate undertaking stating that no capitation fee or any other fund in the name of building fund, etc. will be collected from the students seeking admission in this College.
- d) The Trust should obtain recognition / suitability / affiliation from the Tamil Nadu Nurses and Midwives Council, Chennai, Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi and the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai respectively before admitting the students.

4. The Director of Medical Education is requested to take necessary further action in this matter.

to grant permission to the above Trust to start a School of Nursing to conduct Diploma in Nursing Course. Accordingly, the Government permit the Managing Trustee, Shantha Medical Foundation, Villupuram, Villupuram District to start a School of Nursing in the name and style as "E.S. School of Nursing" at Chennai Trichy Trunk Road, Villupuram, Villupuram District with an annual intake of 20 students from the academic year 2008-2009, subject to the following conditions:-

- a) The Trust should construct its own 150 bedded hospital within a period of three years.
- a) Admission of students shall be made as per the rules framed by the Government from time to time.
- b) Tuition fees including special fees should be collected from the students at the same rates as prescribed by the Government from time to time. The Management should also give separate undertaking stating that no CAPITATION FEE or any other fund in the name of building fund, etc. will be collected from the students seeking admission in the proposed Nursing School.
- c) The Trust should obtain recognition/suitability from the Tamil Nadu Nurses and Midwives Council, Chennai and the Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi respectively before admitting the students.

5. The Director of Medical Education is requested to take necessary further action in this matter.

1<sup>ST</sup> August / 1<sup>st</sup> February. If the date of commencement of examination falls on Saturdays / Sundays or declared Public Holidays, the examination shall begin on the next working day. The University paper will be awarded for 100 mark and Internal 50 marks.

### SCHEME OF EXAMINATION M.Sc

Theory and practical examinations will be conducted at the end of first year and Second year respectively, in the subjects as per syllabus. If the candidate fails, he/she will be allowed to appear in supplementary examinations (December / June) in failed subjects .

1. Maximum number of attempts permitted for each paper is 3 including first attempt.
2. The maximum period to complete the course successfully should not exceed 4 (four) years.
3. Candidate who fails in any subject, shall be permitted to continue the studies into the second year. However the candidates shall not be allowed to appear for the second year examination till he or she clears all subjects of the first year M .Sc Nursing Examination.

### SUBMISSION OF DISSERTATION

The candidate shall submit a dissertation in the field of specialty, **two months before the final examination for valuing the certification.** During the program of study the candidate is required to write a dissertation in his/her specialty.

### **Examination Guidelines**

1. Shall have one regular examination followed by supplementary examination in a year.
2. If a candidate fails in first year they can be promoted to next year.
3. A candidate can take any number of attempts with a condition that maximum period allowed is 6 years. However all previous paper need to be cleared before appearing in the final examination.
4. No institution shall submit student average marks more than 75% i.e, if 40 students are admitted students A=25, B=20, C=22, D =21, E =24  
Average Score = 89.6%  
This will not be accepted by the State Nursing registration Council
5. Minimum pass marks should be 50% in each of the Theory and Practical paper separately.
6. Minimum pass marks shall be 40% for English only.
7. Theory and Practical exams for Introduction to Computer to be conducted as School exam and marks to be send to the SNRC /Board for inclusion in the mark sheet.
8. A candidate has to pass in theory and practical exam separately in each of the paper.
9. If a candidate fails in either theory or practical paper he/she has to reappear for both the papers ( Theory & Practical )
10. Maximum number of candidates for practical examination should not exceed 20 per days.
11. All practical examination must be held in the respective clinical areas.

12. One internal and one external examiner should jointly conduct practical examination for each student.
13. A candidate must have minimum of **80% attendance** (irrespective of the kind of absence) in theory and practical in each subject for appearing for examination.

## COLLEGE GENRAL RULES OF CONDUCT

### Timings:

College timing- 9.30am to 4.45pm.& clinical timing is 8.00am to 4.00pm. & only for 1<sup>st</sup> year B.SC and DGNM 1<sup>st</sup> year the college timing is 8.30am to 4.00 pm.

### Dress code:

1. All students shall wear neat, clear and decent dress. Girls shall wear salwar kameez /Chudidar / Sarees. Boys shall wear Pant and shirts.
2. Students shall wear shoes while attending classes.
3. During the clinical posting students should come in neat & clean uniform with apron.
4. Students found violating the dress code will be sent out of the class by the faculty concerned and also the matter shall be brought to the notice of the Disciplinary committee .

### Identity card:

1. Every student admitted to the college will have to wear the Identity Card during college hours.
2. Students who has lost their ID card has to obtain a duplicate card by payment of Rs. 100/- after the written request made to the Principal

### Punctuality

1. Students are expected to attend the classes and clinical practices regularly and punctually.
2. Students are expected to follow classroom etiquettes.

### Conduct and Discipline

1. A disciplinary committee is constituted with a view to manage students discipline efficiently and effectively. The Disciplinary committee has the power to directly call for an enquiry into any event affecting students discipline on and off campus. They can summon on any students to appear before them in relation to an enquiry into any issues related to student discipline.
2. The disciplinary committee also has the power to request any member of the administration or faculty to assist in the enquiry.
