MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

This Memorandum Of Understanding (MOU) is made On the 04th Day Of May, 2023

BETWEEN

SAVEETHA INSTITUTE OF MEDICAL AND TECHNICAL SCIENCE, SIMATS A DEEMED TO BE UNIVERSITY declared as Such by the Government of India under Section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 by Notification No.F9/2002 U3) of 162 Poonamallee High Road, Chennai Tamilnadu-600 077, INDIA

AND

E.S. College of Nursing, an Institute established and affiliated under The Tamilnadu Dr.M.G.R Medical University, having its registered office at Villupuram, NH-45, Chennai-Trichy Highway, Via Vikravandi, V.Salai, Villupurram. Pincode-605652, Tamilnadu, INDIA

SIMATS University, declared as Such by the Government of India under Section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 by Notification No.F9/2002 U3) of 162 Poonamallee High Road, Chennai, Tamilnadu India and represented by its DR. SHEEJA S. VARGHESE, REGISTRAR, hereinafter referred to as SIMATS (which expression shall, where the context so admits, mean and include its successors, representatives and permitted assigns) of the One Part;

E.S. College of Nursing, an Institute established and affiliated under The Tamilnadu Dr.M.G.R Medical University, having its registered office at Villupuram, NH-45, Chennai-Trichy Highway, Via Vikravandi, V.Salai, Villupurram. Pincode-605652, and represented by its **PRINCIPAL PROF.PORSELVI. M**, hereinafter referred to as 'E.S. College of Nursing' (which expression shall, where the context so admits, mean and include its successors, representatives and permitted assigns) of the Other Part (hereinafter collectively referred to as "the Parties" and individually as "the Party")

WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

Saveetha University has been graded by the UGC as a Category-I University and accredited by NAAC A++ Grad, NIRF 26TH rank in Government of India and 44th Rank in overall NAAC with 'A' Grade and being a teaching and research institution, it is having well-qualified and experienced faculty members.

AND WHEREAS E.S College of Nursing which was established in the year 2008 and affiliated to TNMGRMU, accredited by NAAC with 'B++' Grade with CGPA -2.83 in 1st Cycle and running UG and PG Programme and it has a team of experienced administrators and teachers, state-of-the-art infrastructure, green campus, well-equipped laboratories and library, tie- up with major hospitals and it owns 300 bedded hospital providing the best exposure to students

AND WHEREAS both the Institutions are interested to have an inter-institutional tie-up with the objective to enhance quality of teaching and learning process, research and extension of services by undertaking mutually accepted collaborative activities in the areas of their core competence and have decided to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding so as to record their intention to work together;

NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PREMISES AND MUTUAL COVENANTS HEREINAFTER CONTAINED, THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:-

1.0. Objectives of collaboration

1.1 To collaborate and co-operate with each other in order to enhance the quality of teaching and training to identifying opportunities for field visit, conducting Guest lectures, Seminars, Organizing symposia and conferences.

- 1.2 To provide for exchange of faculty members and students between the institutions for Brain storming sessions of seminars/workshops/conferences;
- 1.3 To provide opportunities for both faculty members and students to use to the maximum the expertise available in both institutions like Simulation Lab, IQAC cell, etc....
- 1.4 To share knowledge resources like Central Library and other digital resources, within the mutually agreed framework.
- 1.5 To work jointly and develop research projects for implementation at institutional, national and or international level like Patent, Scopus/UGC Care/Pub med Publication between the faculty
- 1.6 To share experiences and expertise concerning accreditation, administration and management like NAAC, NIRF, Visiting Professor, Governing council member, Examination panel & etc.
- 1.7 To undertake such other academic and research activities jointly to the mutual benefit of the Parties such as funding research, national/International Grant from Government/Non Government/NGO's

2.0 Intention

The intention of this MoU is to record the parties' understanding in relation to pursuing of academic and research activities as may be agreed to be undertaken jointly by the Parties only. When the collaborative programs is identified and it is decided to carryout it, the Parties will enter into specific agreement for each such collaborative activity containing all relevant terms and conditions, prior to implementation.

3.0 Financial Commitment

This MoU, being a co-operative and collaborative understanding for academic excellence and enhancement of quality of research activities, shall not create any financial and or legal commitment whatsoever on either of the parties hereto, except as may be provided in activity-specific agreement(s) that may be entered into subsequently.

4.0 Implementation and monitoring

4.1. The Parties hereto agree to constitute a four member Steering Committee, consisting of two members nominated by each Party to pursue steps to finalize and co-ordinate collaborative programs that are agreed between the Parties and prepare

- activity-specific Agreement for such programs/ projects. The meeting of the Steering Committee will be held at least once in six months.
- 4.2. The Steering Committee will periodically monitor the progress of collaborative activities under the MoU, ensure compliance of the terms and conditions specified in the Agreement(s) and furnish a progress report to the top Management of each Institution twice in a year.

5.0 Term and termination

- 5.1. This MoU will be in force for a period of Two years from the date of signing of the same and thereafter may be reviewed and renewed for further period of Two years on mutual consent of the Parties hereto, subject to such other terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed upon.
- 5.2. Notwithstanding sub-clause 5.1., this MoU may be terminated at any point of time by either party by issuing a one month notice, in writing, to the other party prior to the desired date of termination. However, both Parties agree that all obligations accrued up to such date of prior termination in respect of the students, staff, funding bodies or other entities are met in full subsequent to the date of such prior termination.

6.0 Notices

All notices required to be served under the terms of this MoU, shall be in writing and considered to be duly served, if the same is delivered either in person by obtaining acknowledgement or posted by registered mail, addressed to the Nodal Officer of the Institution concerned or at the latest address notified to the other Party herein.
